



SWB Special Block

Supplementary feed for deer, fallow deer and mouflons

Ingredients:

Crude protein 12.5 %, crude fat 3.5 %, crude fibre 5.0 %, crude ash 10.5 %, sodium 0.15 %

Composition:

Rye, maize, triticale, maize gluten feed, linseed cake, pumpkin and peanut cake, molasses, calcium carbonate, monocalcium phosphate

Benefits of the Special Block for deer, fallow deer and mouflons:

- Due to a special manufacturing process, the SWB Special Block has a compact and hard structure, which provides for an optimal and sustainable winter feed for game (ruminants). The feed reduces the risk of acidification (acidosis), as contrary to traditional feeding of loose grains, only small quantities mixed with sufficient amounts of saliva get into the rumen.
- The feeding of several pieces of SWB Special Block for deer, fallow deer and mouflons helps reduce stress among the game.
- The game will primarily take in the provided hay (second-cut hay, grass silage etc.), which supports rumination. The SWB Special Block is offered as an additional feed supplement.
- Very good development of venison and trophies.
- Simple feeding, little effort.

Recommended use:

In November, before the snowy and cold winter time begins, several SWB Special Blocks should be provided at the feeding site and preferably on feeding tables. It is essential to make sure that the SWB Special Block is protected against the weather. Provide one SWB Special Block per 10 animals. Later on, from December to mid – late February, you can offer the game some SWB Special Blocks from time to time to keep the feeding site attractive. The game should be fed with the SWB Special Block until the first shedding of the antlers in mid- or late February. The SWB Special Block will positively support the growth of the antlers. Always supplement feed suitable for ruminating such as hay, grass silage or lucerne – ad libitum!
