



SWB Pheasant Block

Supplementary feed for pheasants and partridges

Ingredients:

Crude protein 10.5 %, crude fat 5.5 %, crude fibre 4.9 %, calcium 6.0 %, trace elements

Composition:

Maize, wheat, rye, triticale, molasses, sunflower seeds, shell grit, calcium carbonate, monocalcium phosphate, sodium chloride

Benefits of the Pheasant Block:

- Very good acceptance and occupation; keeps animals in their habitat.
- Species-appropriate composition.
- Ideal complement to other feeding systems.
- No browsing by roe deer.
- No rat and mouse damage.
- Absolutely weather-proof.
- Permanent intake of minerals supports egg laying.
- No fattening of the pheasants.
- Simple application and handling saves time and supports decentralised feeding.

Recommended use:

To put up the feed, remove the "handle" of the bucket from the fastening and insert it into the designated holes in the bottom of the bucket. Cut a hole of approx. 18 cm into the lid of the bucket. The remaining edge of the lid serves as a cover and protects the feed against mice and rats. Make sure that the cover is firmly fixed on the bucket. The bucket is hung up with the aperture facing downwards and in a safe place for pheasants and partridge. The recommended height for pheasants is approx. 30-40 cm and for partridges approx. 15-20 cm. Laying out some feed (maize or wheat) under the suspended Pheasant Block facilitates the adaptation phase. One Pheasant Block feeds 20 pheasants for approximately one month.
